*Exhibition : "Women in Palestine" by Veronique Vercheval*

This exhibition will expose photos of Veronique Vercheval of a number of Palestinian women. This exhibition will be supported by Présence et Action Culturelles (PAC), to present and to discover these faces, as mirrors of the daily lives of women in Palestine. Véronique Vercheval began her career as a photojournalist for Voyelles magazine in 1979. She has conducted long-term documentary and sociological investigations, notably her work for the "Archives de Wallonie" project. She has photographed steel and iron workers, glass makers, miners, nurses, doctors, farmers, road transport workers... From her travels in Palestine, since 2002, the Belgian photographer has brought back images, mostly personal ones, that reveal Palestine far from the clichés that are made. Usually traded here.
